FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners,

Fr. Tom Greisen recently informed me that he will be taking a different assignment in the new year. Fr. Tom has been the Servant Minister to the priests of the Archdiocese for eleven years and had been in residence at St. John Vianney for over three years and has been able to office out of the rectory. As a resident he was present to our parish by helping with our daily and weekend Mass schedule. And he was available for other sacramental and pastoral needs as his time allowed. He will be with our parish until March 1st at which time he will participate in a sabbatical program prior to taking a new assignment that is still to be determined.

With Fr. Tom's departure in March and no prospects for a new priest in residence at St. John Vianney, changes will be necessary in our daily Mass times. Beginning March 1st it will no longer be possible to continue having two daily Masses at St. John Vianney. Because our parish is one of the only parishes with a 9:00 a.m. Mass in our area, I am planning on keeping the 9:00 a.m. daily Mass. Those who desire to attend an earlier morning Mass are encouraged to attend an early morning Mass at one of the neighboring parishes.

I would like to invite you and your family and friends to attend the annual performance of **Handel's Messiah** by the Voices of Omaha next Sunday, November 19, at 3:00 p.m. at the Holland Performing Arts Center. It has been a privilege for me to have sung with this group over the years. This oratorio has always provided me with a prayerful way to conclude the Church Year and to begin the season of Advent. I would like you to consider attending this beautiful Scriptural and musical masterpiece that begins with the comforting words of Isaiah and culminates with the majestic passages of the Book of Revelation including the famous 'Hallelujah' chorus as a way of offering worship and praise to God for Jesus Christ.

Policy Changes for Mass intentions in 2018

Because of changes that will be occurring beginning in March of 2018, the following adjustments will take place regarding daily Mass at St. John Vianney beginning March 1, 2018:

- *There will be one daily Mass at 9am, Monday through Friday.
- *There may be a Mass or Communion Service on Mondays at 9am.
- *There will be no 7am Mass on Saturday.
- *Saturday evening and Sunday morning Mass schedule will remain the same.
- *Mass stipends will remain \$10 for daily Masses and \$15 for weekend Masses.
- *Masses at Good Samaritan will normally be at 10am on the first and third Friday of each month.

The Nurse's Station **DID YOU KNOW?**

*Flu causes millions of illnesses, hundreds of thousands of hospitalizations and thousands of death every season.

*Flu vaccination benefits include reducing flu illnesses, decreasing visits with a provider, decreasing instances of missed work/school, as well as preventing flu-related hospitalization & deaths.

*It takes about 2 weeks after vaccination for protection to occur.

Exclusion Criteria

The only exclusions for the vaccine are the following:

*Age less than 6 months

*Allergy/Sensitivity to vaccine

*Previously immunized in the current season

*History of Guillain Barre within 6 weeks after previous flu vaccine

*Bone Marrow Transplant within 6 months

*Anaphylactic latex allergy

*Organ transplant during current hospital stay (previous transplants are not excluded)
