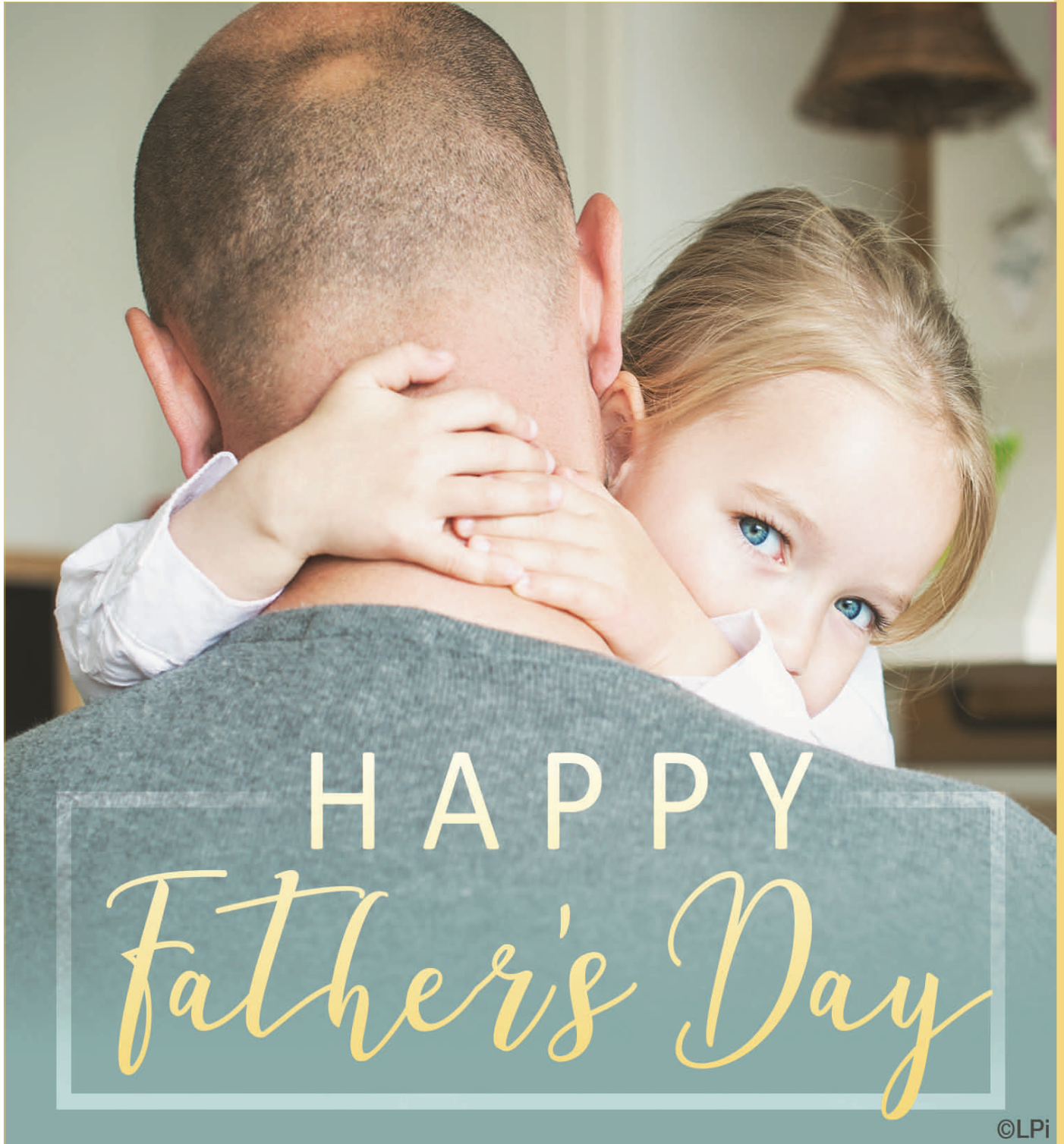

You probably noticed we have some major work being done on the Sandoz side of the Church. The water main broke last Monday and so we were without water in the Church for several days. Sorry for the inconveniences that were caused, but we hope to have things back to normal soon.

Consider a Gift of a Life Insurance Policy

Insurance policies are often bought by individuals or couples with young children to help insure that, in the event of an untimely death of one or both parents, resources are available to help raise the children. Frequently, these policies have an investment element to them as well, which may be borrowed out of the policy for major expenses such as college tuition. Thankfully, in many cases, the insurance never becomes necessary for either of these purposes, which leaves many people trying to figure out what to do with policies that they no longer need. Why not consider a gift of such a policy to St. John Vianney?

If an outright gift of such a policy (i.e., one in which you retain no rights in the policy) is made during your life, you may receive an income tax deduction (subject to certain limitations) equal to the lesser of your investment in the policy (total premiums paid) or its cash surrender value. You may even deduct (again subject to certain limitations) ongoing premiums you pay on the policy on behalf of our parish.

Alternatively, you may just wish to name our parish as beneficiary at your death, which will be deductible for estate tax purposes (if applicable). This would allow you to retain the benefits of the policy during your life, but still benefit our parish at your death with funds that are no longer necessary for the care of your family.

FAQs about being an EMHC or Lector

Q for BOTH: *Will I be trained by someone before I'm put on the schedule? Absolutely. Pattie Money is the EMHC Coordinator and Cher Slavik is the Lector Coordinator. Pattie or Cher will contact you after the Mandation to set up a time to meet here at Church for training.

LECTOR Q: *What if I do not know the correct pronunciation of something? Lectors are given the option to have a lector workbook that contains the readings in large print for easy practice, with words in bold indicating suggestions for emphasis, commentaries that give background and explain the meaning of the reading, margin notes with pronunciation guides and tips for proclamation.

EMHC Q: *Do I have to consume the remaining Precious Blood that is left in my cup? No, if you are unable to consume the remaining Precious Blood, you can leave the cup with the others and the Deacon will consume it after Mass.

Q for BOTH:

***I can't be scheduled every weekend; will I be on the schedule 3 or 4 weekends every month?** No, if you are only able to be on the schedule 1 or 2 times a month, you simply let Cher or Pattie know that ahead of time. If you email them by the 10th of the *previous* month, they will accommodate your schedule requests for the next month.
